

We, the association Les 3 Continents, do not tolerate behaviours such as harassment, discrimination, intimidation, or violence (of a racist, homophobic, transphobic, sexist, sexual, or any other nature).

Each participant in the Festival des 3 Continents and the Produire au Sud workshops, without exception, undertakes to:

- Not categorize a person or their work with an adjective that refers to gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, ethnicity, religious practice or lack thereof, physical appearance, or disability.
- Address the employees or members of the association Les 3 Continents, as well as its volunteers, in a polite and egalitarian manner, avoiding any condescending remarks or statements that could diminish a person to an object.
- Refrain from making comments about people's physical appearance or clothing.
- Refrain from making inappropriate gestures towards others.
 Acknowledge that flirting heavily in the workplace or at a festival can create uncomfortable or tense situations and contribute to harassment.
- Understand that the consumption of alcohol and drugs does not excuse my inappropriate words or behaviours; rather, they are an aggravating factor.
- Respect consent. Consent must always be freely given and informed. It can be withdrawn at any time and cannot be obtained through negotiation and insistence. A single "NO" is sufficient!
 Yielding is not consenting!

I witness harassment or an assault, what should I do?

The 5D's method:

Distract

I take steps to divert the attention of the aggressor or harasser to allow the victim to leave safely.

Dialogue

I communicate directly with the person who has been assaulted or harassed, offering them a sympathetic ear and support if needed after the incident.

Delegate

I seek the assistance of a security officer or designated person to end the situation.

Direct

I step in by confronting the aggressor or harasser and reporting their wrongdoing.

Document

I collect evidence of harassment and assault without direct involvement, to support the victim later.

Who do I contact?

If I am a victim or witness of inappropriate behaviour, I can report these incidents. My report will be heard and taken into account.
