He has also written several feature films that premiered in Berlin International Film Festival (2012) and Venice International Film Festival (2015), and which were also Nepal's Official Entry for Academy Awards in Best Foreign Language Film Section. He is currently preparing for his directorial debut film, Season Of Dragonflies.





SYNOPSIS

Following a devastating earthquake, Rudraawati (40), a feisty breast cancer survivor who lives in a make-shift shelter amidst the rubble, is torn between using her money to rebuild her house, which her family desperately needs, or re-building her breast to reclaim her womanhood and win back her estranged husband. While everyone in her family is busy preparing for the rituals to make Rudraawati's daughter a *Kumari* (the Living Goddess as in *Newari* culture), Rudraawati decides without telling anyone to use the money to reclaim her womanhood. But the consequences of her decision catch up with her and she finds herself isolated, abandoned by the very people that she struggled so hard to hold together. She realises what is truly important to her. Now, she has to learn to take a stand and let go of false constraints. This might be her last chance to find hope and happiness again.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

« Season of Dragonflies comes from extremely personal experience. My cousin, with whom I had spent all my childhood, passed away because of breast cancer. I got to know later about her husband's affair. I doubted that maybe the reason she never told us or blamed him for all of this was because she thought her mastectomy to be the actual cause. What if she had decided to reconstruct her breast? Would that mend her relationship? I then decided to write this story about this woman called Rudraawati, who wants to make decision for herself, and break the barriers; unlike many such Nepali women who rarely get an opportunity to explore or make choice for herself. »
