THUPO is an extraordinary story which deftly explores Botswana's most pertinent social issues, demonstrating that tyranny prevails only because it is supported by the corrupt morals of a community, leaving our children to pay the biggest price. This story is a call to action, demanding Batswana, Africans and ultimately the world to rise up against injustice. We must all choose to do what is right over what is easy because even the smallest choice made by a single person can change the course of a society's future. It only takes one; then it takes a village.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Sayeda is a pregnant woman who is infected by the virus and is about to give birth, how will they deal with her, and how even she will go to the hospital if this happens during the curfew in a small village in Egypt where there are no hospitals and how the people in her village will deal with her if they know that she is infected by the virus.

My parents have been born and grew up in villages in Egypt and my aunts are still living there with their families we were always going there on our vacations, and I know how bad the health care is they have, in addition to the poverty and poor education there.

Moreover, the film is to give a statement on how illiteracy, poor education, and poor health care can affect people's lives in a bad way, and the film can raise awareness for those people in all the Egyptian suburbs on how to deal with each other in such situations and times.
